

Health and Safety at Planète Française

All parent(s)/legal guardian(s) please print and provide a signed copy of the following on the first day of camp. Thank you. It may seem like a lot of items to pack each day but, you will be better off for it.



Camp Checklist:

- Backpack – clearly labelled with Camper's name
- Sun Protection – hat and loose light clothing (especially on really hot days) – protective SPF clothing would be ideal.
- Sunscreen (apply prior and during camp)
- Sneakers or really comfortable rubber soled closed toe shoes -> great for running around and getting exposed to water on occasion.
- T-shirt, Shorts or anything comfortable for movement
- Long-Sleeve top for cooler days (keep in backpack)
- Drink Bottle (filled with water) -> will be refilled throughout camp day
- "Litterless" and Peanut and Nut-free -> morning snack and lunch.
- Reusable spoon, fork, small plate and cup* (*only if in after-care)
- Swim suit and towel in separate bag within backpack.
- Read and understand camp/ground rules prior to enjoying your weekly programs
- Healthy – if you have any communicable infections, please refrain from coming and we hope to get better really soon.

Ground Rules = Camp Rules

We have a few, but they are vitally important to our team at Planète Française as they are to every camper, parent/guardian and any and all individuals associated with the camp. Please review, understand and follow these ground rules prior to each camp session.

- **Peanut and nut-free Policy:** We are operating as a peanut and nut-free "SAFE" camp. Please do not bring any products containing these ingredients near or on school grounds.
- Please do not bring any electronics, sports or personal items to camp. We will not be responsible for lost or damaged personal property.
- Please sign-in and sign-out your child at the start and end of each camp day. Pick-up will always be on the school grounds in the designated area.
- Please contact the camp if you know your child will be absent on a particular camp day – we will miss them.
- All campers must stay within a designated area which has been defined by their camp counselor. No one is allowed to leave an area unless approved by their camp counselor and they have a buddy or counselor for children who are under 6 yrs. Campers must ask their counselor if they are unclear about the defined "designated area".
- Campers will attend camp during camp hours (9am-4pm), unless the camp Director receives 24 hours written notice of different arrival or departure.
- Healthy – if you have any transferrable sickness or communicable infections, please refrain from coming and we hope to get better really soon. A Doctor's note will be accepted and credit note will be applied as value towards another camp program within the 2014 summer season. Sorry, we do not refund camp programs.
- All campers along with camp staff will wash and disinfect their hands prior to handling any/all food and drinks.
- All campers will a serious allergy must inform their counselors and carrying an EpiPen.
- Campers will conduct themselves with respect to all individuals (this includes, other campers, staff, parents and any and all other individuals within the designated camp area) and the physical environment (this includes school and outside of school property and any and all areas defined as a designated camp area). As such there will be zero tolerance to the following behaviours/actions and Counselors and Camp Directors will take appropriate action to resolve the behaviour, including but not limited to removing the individual camper, suspending to terminating their camp program(s) for the remaining summer.
This includes but not limited to the following: any theft or intentional damage to properties of individual(s) or grounds, bullying, use and wearing of profane and/or derogatory words/statements and engaging in any/all criminal activity.

The camp staff will always engage in positive behaviour modification and construction conflict resolution for any/all negative behaviour which arises during a camp session. We will give a verbal warning with behaviour modification to removal of a child from an activity to a child sent to a Summer Director for conflict resolution to contacting parent/guardian to pick-up their child if problem does not get resolved. The goal is to have a positive outcome for all involved. If the behaviour continues and does not improve, the camper will need to be removed from the camp grounds and dismissed from the remainder of camp to termination from all 2014 summer camp programs. Parents/legal Guardians will be told when their child has behaved inappropriately.
